

Rockin' The Schools

(available October – June)

Rockin' the Schools programs include an interactive class of approximately one hour, the opportunity to tour the Museum exhibits, and materials for teachers to extend learning before and after the museum visit. Each class engages students in actively exploring the history of rock and roll, while meeting and exceeding Ohio Academic Content Standards for learning in the arts and other core subject areas. The Museum's award winning educators involve students in exploring topics in music, language arts, social studies, science, and technology through demonstrations, musical examples, video excerpts, and multimedia presentations.

The eight core programs are offered throughout the academic year (October to June) on Tuesdays through Fridays at 10am and 11:30am in the Museum's media equipped Fourth Floor Theater. Specialty programs are offered during specific months to connect to Museum-wide events, such as the American Music Masters celebration and Black History Month.
