Rockin' the Schools programs include an interactive class of approximately one hour, the opportunity to tour the Rock Hall exhibits, and materials for teachers to extend learning before and after the visit. Our on-site, interdisciplinary classes on the history of rock & roll meet and exceed academic content standards. Classes draw on the power of rock & roll to get students excited about academic content areas from fine arts, language arts, and social studies to mathematics, science, and technology. The seven core programs are offered throughout the academic year (October to June) on Tuesdays through Fridays at 10am and 11:30am in the Rock Hall's state-of-the-art Foster Theater.
