### Artifacts and throughout the museum:

- A fancy costume
- A lyric sheet
- A piece of technology (non-instrument)
- A plain costume
- A shiny artifact
- An artifact with a cool story (rock star level if you summarize the story on camera in front of the artifact)
- One artifact from each decade, starting with the 1940s and finishing in 2020
- Take an excited selfie on the bridge outside the Power of Rock Experience (level 3)
- The coolest instrument
- The most unique artifact
- Two of the same type of instrument
- Your favorite or the most unique signature on level 3 (selfie opportunity!)

### Family Fun Day:

- Photo or video yourself or a friend or family member dancing to the live music on the plaza
- Take a photo of a friend or family member participating in the games on Family Fun Day
- Take a photo of the live music performer rocking out on Family Fun Day

### Around the Building:

- Eating by the food trucks
- Find the sign outside the Rock Hall that explains one of the reasons the Rock Hall is in Cleveland
- Making a peace hand sign or rock horns hand sign in front of the building
- Strike a pose in front of the “Long Live Rock” letters
- Your group by the lake with the Rock Hall in the background (rock star level if by the Cleveland sign in the park)

### Expert level:

- Interview an adult in your group on video and ask them:
  - o About their favorite artist and why (rock star level if near an artifact from that artist)
  - o A memory of their favorite artist or concert (rock star level if near an artifact from that artist or concert)

- Find a YouTube video of an instrument or costume you saw at the Rock Hall in action
